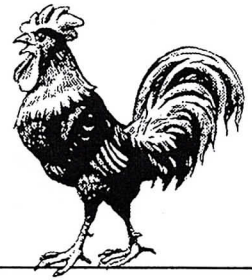

Greetings Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

It is summer time and an exciting time for our Emmaus community. We have Walk #63 led by Debbie Eifling coming up but also Chrysalis Flights 15 and 16. As we support Emmaus Walks with our attendance at sponsor's hour, candlelight and closing so we should also support our youth with our prayers and attendance. Chrysalis has taken on a special significance for me as my daughter will be attending. As we pray for Debbie and team let us also pray for John Corban and Renee Errington and their teams as they lead our youth. We as Christians hold a special responsibility to lead our children and Chrysalis is a special step for them. The Board has been busy, as we are in the process of selecting our future Lay Directors. We also have agreed to sponsor a new Emmaus community on the Gulf Coast. The new community will cover an area in need of an Emmaus community. John Garrot has taken the lead role in this. As we are in the infant stages of this we ask that you pray for this new ministry as we work out details for this community to have it's first Walk hopefully by the fall of next year. We also are continuing to strive to follow the model of the Upper Room and make each Walk consistant from one Walk to the next. As we continue to stress wise sponsorship and as each of you know the duties associated with this responsibility, a special part of each Walk is the time a pilgrim receive their letters from loved ones. We ask you designate no more than 12 letters in this manner. This will make the agape committee's job a lot easier and then you will know that the pilgrims received the letters that have a special meaning. They can read the rest of their letters when they return home. Also we ask that all agape arrives on Thursday afternoon.

Emmaus has been a very special step to many of us in our Walk with Christ. To many it was a time of renewal, some a time to strengthen a love for Him and for some a time to receive Him as our Lord and Savior. Sponsor someone and pass this opportunity along to a friend or loved one as a gift of love. Central Ms. Emmaus is a great community and may it continue to grow in God's grace.
