Don't Sit On It

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: . . . to share your food with the hungry and . . . when you see the naked, to clothe him?" (Isaiah 58: 6, 7)

George Washington was a master motivator. In the winter of 1777 his soldiers were facing a lot of stressful conditions, including icy cold weather. The morale of the army dropped; the men started grumbling and complaining. Quite suddenly Gen. Washington gave orders to build a new fort and to build it quickly. The soldiers snapped out of their "attitude" and got to work, thinking their General knew something they didn't know – like they were going to be attacked shortly. So they worked very hard that winter on the new fort. When spring came, the soldiers were shocked when Washington gave the order to move to another location. One of the officers asked him, "Why are we moving when the fort isn't even finished?" To which Gen. Washington replied, "It has served its purpose and that was to keep you and the rest of the men busy on something you thought was important.

George Washington exercised much wisdom with this enterprise, boosting the morale of his men, which prepared them for the battles that lay ahead. But he was actually acting on a principle that God spelled out many centuries ago. God knows we need a mission, we need a purpose, because He made us that way. He did not create us to be couch potatoes, but movers and shakers, visionaries – people who make a difference. When we don't have a vision, and indulge in our wants and desires with time to do them, that's when the trouble starts. In fact this is what the Bible says was the big problem for Sodom and Gomorrah. Ezekiel 16: 49 says, "This was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter had pride, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy."

Money, things that money can buy, "fullness of food," and lots of leisure time are not the road to happiness. We will only find genuine inner joy and contentment when we are doing what God created us to do. And
