Put on your armor

Sadly enough, Satan is alive and well in this world and continues to throw darts at our Emmaus Community. Daily I contend with this and when I do I like to turn to the passage in Ephesians 6: 10 & 11; "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. We always say as part of the 4th Day talk (and that's what Emmaus is all about) that the closer we get with God, the more Satan attacks us. Therefore put on the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, shod your feet with readiness, take up your shield of faith and put on your helmet of salvation. The last two pieces Paul tells us to wear is the sword of the spirit, which is the word of God, and to pray. Stay in God's word and prayer for each other and God will give us the victory.

So what I am going to do as we head into a new year and me being a new President of your Board, is ask each of you to put on your armor, the armor of God. Stay in His Word (The Holy Bible) and pray. Pray, not for our will to be done, but for God's will to be done in our personal lives and in the life of this community.
