Elect Leaders for Christ

"And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight to help you to determine what is best..." Philippians 1:1-26 (NRSV)

Paul's affection for the church in Philippi reminds me a lot of our affection for this community and The Walk to Emmaus. Paul begins the letter by referring to fond memories (vs. 1). Isn't it the memory of our own personal Walks and the power of the Risen Christ in our three-day experience that gives us the passion for this ministry? And isn't it even more true, "that the One who began a good work among you (on your personal Walk) will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ" (vs. 6)? The mission of the Emmaus movement is to raise leaders in the local church. Paul's mission: to raise leaders in the church plant of Philippi. Are we doing every thing possible in our 4th days to raise leaders for Christ? Paul was sitting in jail and still offering impeccable sponsorship to his pilgrims.

Every year the new Class of Board of Directors will attend a training session in the southeast region. Although this does adhere to the age-old adage "knowledge is power," it's much more than that.
