Dear Emmaus Community,

Excitement is building for the upcoming walks not only because we "Expect a Miracle" in the lives of the pilgrims, but also because we will experience corporate worship with a community of believers who hold a special place in our heart and memory. Thursday night, Saturday night and Sunday afternoon the Emmaus community will gather to "glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ" with one heart and mouth, just as Paul writes. He wasn't asking the Church in Rome to agree on everything; Paul was asking that there be a "spirit of unity." We can only truly worship when business is set aside and God's will is our soul's purpose. Verse seven continues, "Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God." How did Christ accept us? "While we were still sinners..." We are not perfect, but we are the Body, the Central Mississippi Walk to Emmaus Community of believers.

• The entire team may sing the Servant's Song at Breakfast on Sunday and give their name and job on the current walk, without mentioning individual walk information.

• There is no Balloon Release Service. However there will be balloon agape and a helium tank to be used as the agape and food committee deem decoratively appropriate.

• The Committee Team does not participate in placemat exchange or jokes during meals.

• Music Leaders do not give talks.

• The Priority and 4th Day talks are given by ALD's.

• Do not ask pilgrims their occupation as a part of My New Best Friend.

• Lanyards are not worn by anyone until after the cross ceremony. Exception: by the speaker during each of the 15 talks.

• Committee team eats meals in the Dining Hall with plain white placemats at a table in the back by the fireplace.

• There is a 1-hour break on Saturday after lunch. If there are questions on the Means of Grace talk, the SD will make himself/herself available after lunch in the chapel.

• Candlelight is conducted by the traditional CMWE model.

• Agape may have the name of individuals, churches or reunion groups on it.

These are the rules. If you have any questions please email me, I will take them to the next Board meeting on Thursday, April 30th. Things have been written down, voted on, and resolved by past Boards. There is no reason for inconsistency or confusion. Please let a Board member know if things still remain unclear.

Also, the Board decided at the last meeting that in order to be good stewards and fiscally responsible, the maximum number of pilgrims on a Walk will be 30- 5 tables of six pilgrims. Please adjust your agape accordingly.

Lastly, I received several emails regarding the format change of the Gathering. We will be using the second of three options in the Upper Room Handbook at the next Gathering. Remember, this is just a trial period in an effort to "raise this service from the dead"! Any feedback will be helpful. In the second format the 4th Day witness will be someone from the community living that witness on a daily basis. Please email me any suggestions on who that witness may be from your community. For now, the Closing will serve as the opportunity for the community to hear from the freshest members of our community, so please plan to attend this Sunday at 4pm. The Gathering will be a time for us to love on them,

introduce ourselves, and offer hope through testimony of 4th day life. Worship is an important part of the Gathering as well, so please let Kay Black or Susie Kimbrough know if there is someone from your church in the Emmaus, Chrysalis or Cursilio Community who leads worship and would like to serve.

Thank you for all you do to raise leaders in our various churches. There are many community-wide ways to serve for those of you interested. For instance we are looking for someone to serve as CMWE's treasurer, an appointed position by the Board. It does not require board meeting attendance and there is a finance committee in place to serve alongside you. We need a nametag maker (for lack of better words). This person is responsible for making the nametags that the pilgrims receive at the check in table on Thursday night. We have the equipment; we just need a servant! Wherever God has gifted you, let us know. There is an act of service for everyone in this Body.
