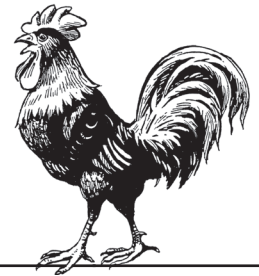

“I shall be there!” “Will you be there?”

Have you ever been invited by someone to attend an event or to go somewhere with them and simply responded “I’ll be there”? I think we have all had that experience and used that phrase several times in a social setting. Has a friend or family member ever called you during a difficult time and you responded by saying something such as “Where are you?” Followed by the statement “I will be there!” Then you quickly jump in your car and drive to their home, hospital, or location of need. You did this to offer your support and your love to that individual. How many of you have been on the receiving end of this scenario? How comforting was it to know that someone was there for you? Again, this is probably something we have all done and all experienced.

I have recently learned a special meaning for the statement, “I shall be there”, through a Bible Study by James W. Moore. Exodus 3: 1-20 tells us the story of Moses and the burning bush. God instructs Moses by saying “Go, Moses, Set my people free. Go, and I will go with you”, (Exodus 3:12). Moses was facing a dangerous mission and he was frightened as well. Moses did not want to have to face Pharaoh and he felt he did not have any authority over Pharaoh. So Moses asks God, “Who shall I say sent me? What is your name?” (Exodus 3:13). God replies, “I am who I am” (Exodus 3:14). How many times have we heard or read that passage? It is a powerful statement but I have learned it is even more powerful and more special. Martin Buber, an Old Testament scholar, after many years of study feels that translation may not be correct. His studies have revealed that the translation of the phrase “I am who I am” should really read “I Shall Be There!”. How wonderful and powerful is that statement!!! We know God was most certainly with Moses and we can
