The Company of the Committed

An old letter from the spring of 2008, written by Julian Crawford, is below. I hope you enjoy these words from a man with a heart for Jesus who lives his walk each and every day.

I will encourage each of you to read all of John 6, but especially to pay attention to verses 66-69. What is happening here is that Jesus' followers have just been chastised for being selfish and thinking only of themselves. Jesus has told them they were wrong and they would have to do some things they did not want to hear or do. So they began to quit and no longer followed him. Jesus then turned to the Twelve and asked if they wanted to quit also. This makes me think of the people who followed Jesus, and when I do, they can clearly be divided into 3 groups.

I will call the first group the "company of the curious". The reason great multitudes followed Jesus was they were curious to hear what he had to say or to watch the miracles. Curious people, and we have them in our churches today, come to see what's going on. They come to church but can never be a part of the church. Christianity to them is like an artificial limb, they can put it on or take it off as the situation warrants.

The second group is the "company of the convinced". They are convinced their way is the only way. The crowd wanted to make Jesus their king the way they wanted Him to be king. They wanted Jesus to do as they wanted and not them doing what Jesus wanted. These are the people in a church who do most of the work. Why? Because they are convinced that is what they are supposed to be doing. Curious people come to church; convinced people work in the church doing what they want to do.

That brings us to our third group, the "company of the committed". They are the church. And let me make it clear what I mean when I say "church". A church is a group of born again Christians who come together to worship and praise God, to lift one another up, and to grow in grace. Jesus did not die for a bunch of bricks or a particular group of people. Look at who stayed to follow Jesus. A group of 12 common, ordinary, uneducated men with many faults. But when they let Jesus take control of their lives, those 12 ordinary men changed the world. They had no where to go but to Jesus. And He can do the same for us. We can accomplish much if we put Jesus at the controls doing what He wants us to do. I encourage each of you to deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow Jesus. On His terms. In His way. You do not want to leave too, do you? Which of these groups best describes you?
