What is God preparing you for?

You have surrendered your life to God and have trusted your future into his hands. Everything is flowing smoothly until.....you come to the inevitable crossroads in your journey. Typical questions of directional instruction are laid before God in a panicked rush of "need to know now" mentality. Maybe we are afraid of making the wrong choices and then having to deal with the proverbial U-turn to get back on the right way. Maybe we have a habit of making the wrong choices and know all too well where the wrong direction will take us. Maybe this is our first time at the crossroads and it's a foreign concept that we do not quite understand. Whatever your experience or purpose at the Crossroads, know that when we are in Christ, he will lead, guard, and guide us...BUT....we have to go in the direction he tells us without looking back and trust him completely. Easy concept, hard to do.

Let me encourage you today with a few scriptural examples of people who trusted God in big ways. May it help you when you have to choose a path at your crossroads

Hebrews 11 tells us that the "great cloud of witnesses" have gone before us: Noah, Abel, Enoch, Sarah, Rahab, Moses, and Abraham. They did not start with the big things that they are known for in the Bible. Their walk with God started long before with promises, asking God in the little things and gradually building a relationship that eventually led them to the crossroads that required trust in a big thing. What they learned in the little steps of obedience solidified their confidence in God in the big steps. Scripture tells us Luke 16:10 that "whoever can be trusted with little can also be trusted with much." Let's begin the habit of taking everything little thing before God and trusting him to lead us so that when the bigger things come, we are already in tune with hearing God's voice and are prepared for Him to lead us as we trust him completely.

Great faith begins with each small step. What is God calling you to do? Where is he calling you to go? What is that "nagging little voice" telling you? When we ask the Lord to make it "ridiculously clear", he will. Trust him to know what is best. He doesn't call the equipped, he equips the called.

Boldly. Fearlessly. Confidently. Walk with one foot in front of the other. And if you happen to get scared, walk scared. He will not let your foot slip (Psalm 121:3).

Trust him and obey.
