Servant Lay Leadership

Christ is the ultimate example of servant leadership. As Christ followers, we are instructed to follow His example and put into action the traits that He modeled to His disciples and taught to those who followed Him. Matthew 20: 25-28 tells us what servant leadership all about. Jesus tells his disciples, "Whoever wants to be great must become a servant. Whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave. This is what the Son of Man has done. He came to serve-and then to give away his life in exchange for the many who are held hostage."

A servant leader has a sense of God's calling, a calling that requires service, submission, and sacrifice. What traits do we look for in a leader that suggest his fundamental orientation is Christlike servanthood? This list is by no means complete, but some fundamental indications:

- 1: A servant leader seeks the glory of his Master. Jesus said, "The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory, but the one who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood" (John 7:18)
- 2: A servant leader sacrificially seeks the highest joy of those he serves. He will make necessary sacrifices in order to pursue people's "progress and joy in the faith," which results in the greater glory of God (Philippians 1:25; 2:9-11)
- 3: A servant leader will forgo his rights rather that obscure the gospel. A servant leader's identity and trust is not in his calling, but in his Christ.
- 4: a servant leader is not preoccupied with personal visibility and recognition. "He doesn't view those with less visible roles as less significant, nor does he covet more visible roles as more significant" (1 Corinthians 12:12-26).
- 5: A servant leader anticipates and graciously accepts the time for his decrease. All leaders serve only for a season, some long, some short, but all seasons end. When John the Baptist recognized the ending of his season, he said, "Therefore this joy of mine is now complete. He must increase, but I must decrease" (John 3:29-30).

We have many servant leaders that work tirelessly to ensure that each walk is executed properly. Among these great leaders is John Rose. John is retiring from his positions on the board and moving to Florida with his family to start a new chapter in his life. John wore many hats on our Emmaus board – most were not visible, but nonetheless crucial to the function of the Emmaus Walk. While he worked diligently as the Treasurer, he also set up the Thursday night film, checked all microphones to ensure they were working properly, brought supplies to the camp for each walk, took the team/pilgrim picture, and many other important tasks that are too numerous to list. We will miss you John and wish you God's best as you start this new chapter.
