

## Are You Salty?

Matthew 5:13, "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot."

Have you ever eaten a baked potato or scrambled egg without salt, Yuck!! Whenever salt is added to food, the taste is enhanced, and that's how Christlike character, words, and actions can flavor our witness and open the door for people to hear our message.

The salt of the earth preserves and protects! By dehydrating food, it preserves it from spoiling. An article in the Scientific American, explains the effects of salt: "...these processes not only prevent spoilage of foods, but more importantly serve to inhibit or prevent growth of food-borne pathogens such as Salmonella or Clostridium botulinum when properly applied." Salt both preserves and protects.

One of the simplest things salt does is make people thirsty. Chemically, salt makes us thirsty because our brain sends a signal to drink water to balance sodium levels in the blood. For Christians, we can take a cue from our food. Just as our brains create a desire for water, our lives should create a desire in people for the living water of Jesus. Does your life make people thirsty for Jesus?

Do the people around you sense something special about you and thirst to know what it is? Becoming salt of the earth isn't simply a matter of being good, it's a work of the Holy Spirit. When His fruit is produced in us, our life will bear the flavor of Christ

So the big question is: "Are you salty?"
